High production capacity

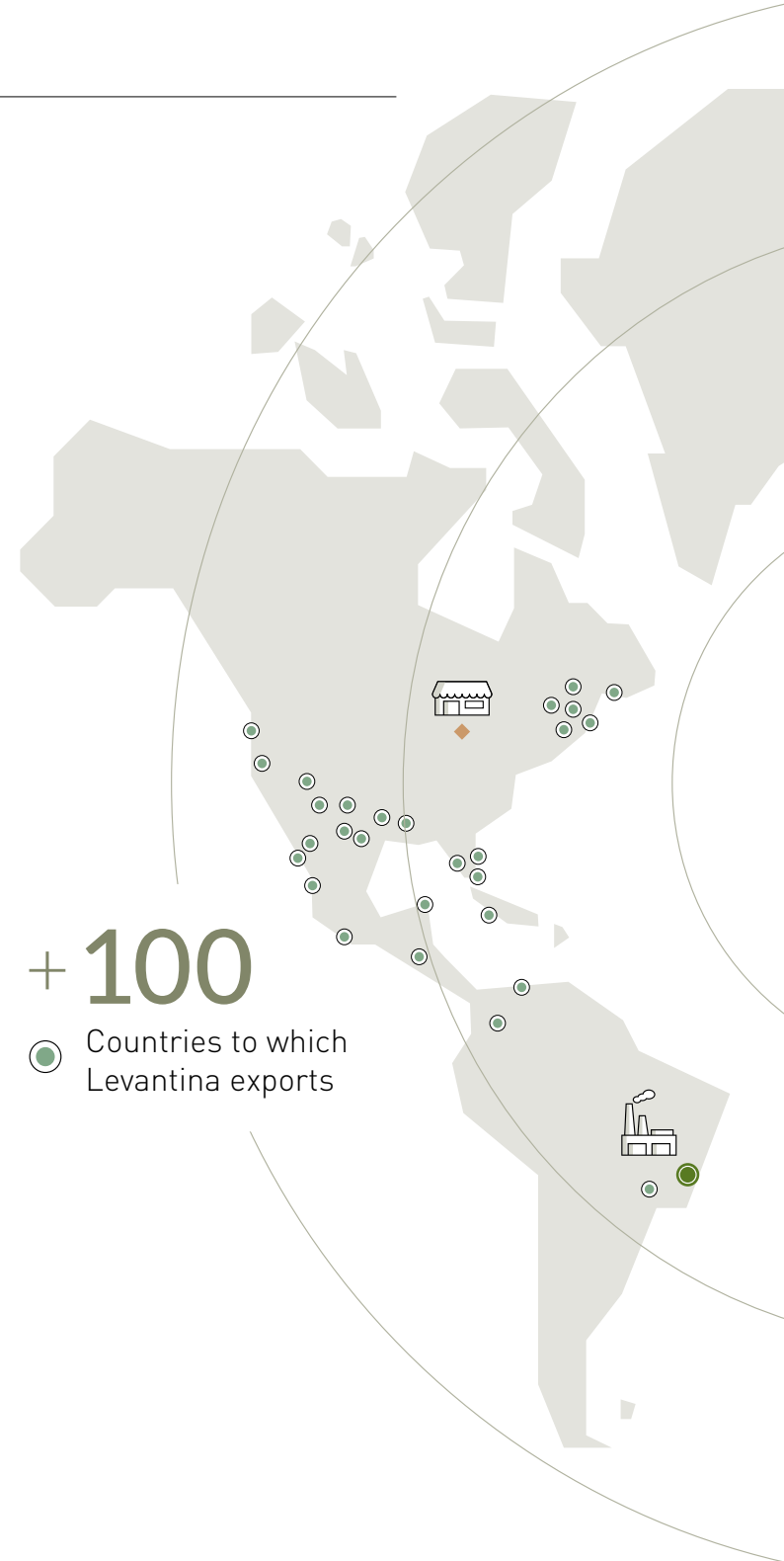
